 Reformed Church Chester N. Jersey. The
 Organ to have one Manual and a Pedal
 of 20 Notes from C.C. 16. feet to g
 Compass of Manuals from C.C. 8. feet to g in alt 56
 To be enclosed in a suitable case made of
 pine, grained oak, and to contain the following
 Stops and arrangements viz

named church and have the same done on
or about the first of November next

In Consideration Whereof the
afore said Doctor Hedges & Dr. J. B. Mattison do hereby
covenant and agree to pay the aforesaid J. H. & C. S. Odell
in lawfull Money the sum of Eleven hundred and
fifty dollars on the fulfillment of the above agreement
also agree to pay freight of organ and expenses of
men to set the said organ up in the above named
church in Chester N. J. (no charge for labor)
