

Truly one of a kind, this 3/26 in the Varsity Theatre, Evanston, Illinois was the largest Geneva theatre organ ever built, replete with picket fence, even! The organ chambers featured some goodies too, such as a Gottfried post horn, brass trumpet, a floating string division and a set of five Chinese temple blocks. Identity of the organist is not known.

This 2/8 in the Lincoln Theatre, Lincoln, Illinois was apparently built during the transition from Smith-Geneva to Geneva Organ Company. Its nameplate reads "A. F. Johnson, Geneva, Illinois."
