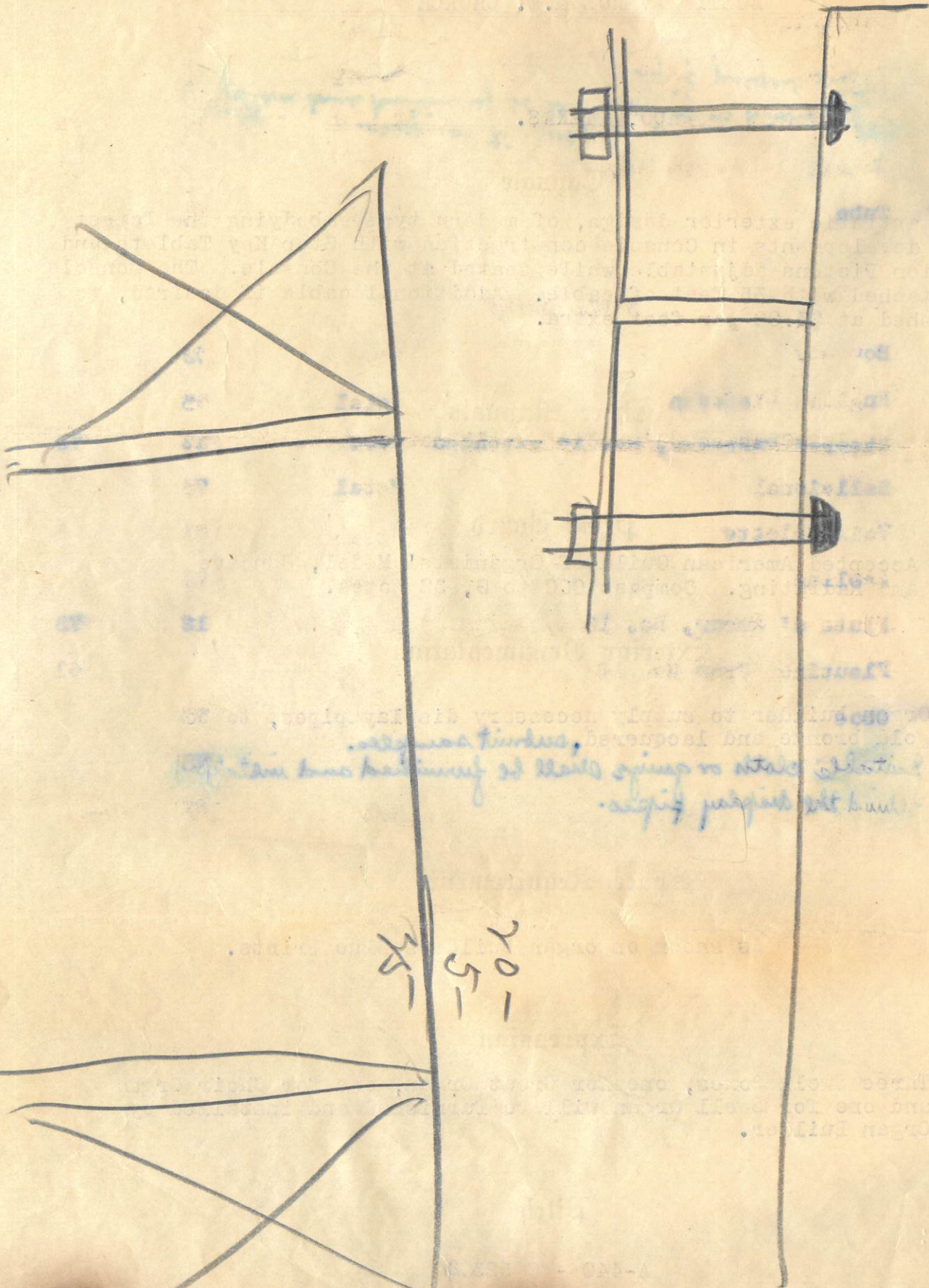

Submitted herewith is a schedule of the material to be furnished and the work to be done by the S. B. Swigert Company, Waco, Texas, in building the Chamber proposed for the Echo Organ in the attic of your church.

The Chamber will be constructed as follows:- 2"x4" studding frame work, single matched flooring and sheet rock walls and ceiling on inside only of framing. There must also be prepared in one side a frame (details of construction of which will be furnished by us) to support expression shutters to be furnished by us. This also involves the construction of a tone horn and the breaking of an opening through the ceiling of the church to be filled with a suitable grille, which will be finished to harmonize with the interior decoration of the auditorium. The walls and ceiling of both Chamber and Tone Horn will receive two coats of white paint. The room will be supported along two wooden trusses distributing the added weight to four of the steel roof trusses. The catwalk which runs along the attic from front to back at present will be widened.

This sub-contract also includes the installation of 8" galvanized iron wind-trunk from the Blower Room to the Organ Chamber.

This subcontract also includes the furnishing of the material and the installation of a 15" wind-trunk from the Blower Room into the main Organ Chamber where three 12" branches will be taken off.

This work is to be finished throughout according to our instructions. Sketches and detailed specifications will be furnished where indicated. There will be no alterations to the building unless approved by authorized officers of the Austin Avenue M. E. Church, and such alterations will be finished in a manner to harmonize with the immediate surroundings and the decorative treatment of the building.

The labor and material for this sub-contract will be furnished by the S. B. Swigert Company for the sum of \$796.00.

It is hereby agreed that if any change is made in the construction of the Echo Organ Chamber which shall reduce the sub-contractors estimated cost the church will derive the benefit of the aforementioned reduction.

Submitted herewith is a schedule of the material to be furnished and the work to be done by the Doyle Electric Company, Waco, Texas, in installing the proposed Pipe Organ in your church.

The Doyle Electric Company will furnish and install necessary wiring for a motor connection for a 3 H.P., 3 Phase, 220 Volt Motor, complete with magnetic switch and remote control push button station and plate at the console. They will install connection at the console and furnish a suitable reading lamp for the console to cost approximately \$4.00, and a pedal lamp with wire guard to cost approximately \$2.50. They will install two drop-lights on the ceiling of the Organ Chamber with 100 Watt Globes and switch control on the wall; there will also be two twin receptacles on the rear wall of the Organ Chamber with 25' of flexible cord in each. Two No. 4 wires will be run from the generator through the rear wall of the Organ Chamber for power.

There is also included in this sub-contract the running of two No. 4 wires from the generator to the Echo Organ Chamber for power. Two electric lights will be strung in the attic and one in the Echo Organ Chamber. There will also be a twin receptacle installed in the Echo Organ Chamber with 25' of flexible cord. Electric bulbs of suitable size will be furnished throughout.

All the above work will be done in a workmanlike manner according to our instructions and to comply with City Ordinances. Sketches and detailed specifications will be furnished where indicated. There will be no alterations to the building unless approved by authorized officers of the Austin Avenue M. E. Church, and such alterations will be finished in a manner to harmonize with the immediate surroundings and the decorative treatment of the building.

The labor and material for this sub-contract will be furnished by the Doyle Electric Company for the sum of \$199.25.

It might be well to note here that the power unit consists of a 3 H.P. General Electric Motor, a suitable Blower and 20 ampere Generator, all to be furnished and installed by us.

Organ Contract

XX Party of the Second Ark will care for said organ and will insure the same for the value thereof, PAYABLE to the Party of the First Part as the interest may appear. Said instruments be obtained and delivered immediately to the Party of the First Part so long as the party of said organ take destination and the Party of the Second Ark further agrees to protect said property against injury and improvidence. Risk of damage or loss by fire or theft assumed by the Party of the Second Ark.

~~XXXX The said organ, its appurtenances and attachments, shall be and remain personal property, and shall not be deemed XXXX to be real estate for the purpose of this agreement.~~

9. It is further agreed that in the event of the failure of the Party of the Second Part to pay the said purchase price or any part thereof, as herein provided, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Party of the First Part may enter into the premises and into the house and buildings occupied by the Party of the Second Part, or other premises or place or places where the said property is or may be located, and take possession of and remove such property therefrom, with or without legal process, and in such case it is expressly agreed that such Party of the First Part may retain all moneys previously paid, as and for compensation for the use of such property by such Party of the Second Part.

10. The Party of the First Part undertakes to replace or repair any parts of the instrument that may fail through defective workmanship or material for a period of two years from date of installation free of charge and for twenty-eight years thereafter, providing Party of the Second Part pays the cost of labor, material, transportation, hotel and meals; provided, however, that no repair work has been done on said organ without the written consent of the Party of the First Part; this guarantee does not include or refer to tuning or regulating.

11. Party of the First Part reserves the right to demonstrate organ at any reasonable time.

12. Notice is hereby given that no oral contract or agreement contrary to any of the terms and conditions of the foregoing has been made, and that none other than the duly authorized officers of the Party of the First Part may vary the terms of this agreement.

13. This contract is to be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri, and is not binding upon the Parties of the First Part until executed by its President, Vice-President or Treasurer, at its home office in St. Louis, Missouri, and attested by the Secretary of said Company under its official seal.

However, this contract shall be binding upon the Party of the Second Part from and after the date of its execution by the Party of the Second Part, unless the Party of the First Part refuses to accept said contract within a period of twelve (12) days from the execution thereof by the Party of the Second Part.

14. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day and year first above written.

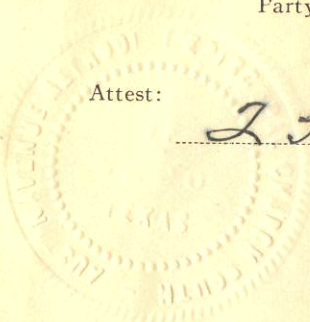
