MANUALS

Compass CC to C4, 61 Notes.

PEDAL

Compass CCC to G. 32 Notes.

ACTION

Reuter's Pitman, Electro-Pneumatic.

REGISTRATION

Controlled by Stop Keys.

CONSOLE

Detached. The console case to be Reuter's standard contemporary design

without roll top.

CASEWORK

None, except console case. Casework as may be desired for the enclosure of the chests and other action parts of the exposed divisions of the organ to be furnished by the purchaser.

EXPRESSION ENCLOSURE

An expression enclosure of plywood construction to enclose the Swell division and portions of the Positiv (when installed) and Pedal divisions, is to be furnished by The Reuter Organ Company. The expression shutters and the exposed portions of the enclosure will be surfaced with oak or other suitable hardwood and finished to harmonize with the other woodwork in the building.

INSTALLATION

The Great, Positiv, and Pedal divisions (except where otherwise indicated), are to be placed in functionally exposed positions within the gallery. The pipework is to be arranged in an attractive design commensurate with the design of the church. The Positiv (when installed) is to be placed in a cantilevered position projecting into the nave beyond the gallery rail. Any such structural supports as may be required to support this cantilevered division are to be furnished by the purchaser. The Swell division is to be placed in an expression enclosure, this to be furnished by The Reuter Organ Company
