The undersigned, THE AEOLIAN COMPANY, hereby agrees to deliver f.o.b. cars Garwood, New Jersey, and install in connection with the Organ to be installed in the residence of Mr. William F. Raskob, Wilmington, Delaware, who agrees to purchase and pay for as hereinafter set forth, one Concertola equipped with ~~Two~~ Controllers and constructed in the manner which is at present standard with The Aeolian Company, the said delivery and installation to be completed during the month of _____, for and in consideration of the sum of ~~Thirty Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.-)~~ which the said Mr. William F. Raskob agrees to pay in New York exchange upon completion of the installation.

It is understood that this agreement includes a Case for the Concertola of American Walnut only of standard design and finish, but does not include the electric wiring necessary to start the Organ motor from the Concertola.

It is further understood that the Concertola mechanism and Case are at the risk of the purchaser from the time of arrival upon his premises. Purchaser to provide and install conduits if necessary.

The foregoing covers all agreements and conditions between the parties thereto, and becomes valid when accepted by both the purchaser and a duly authorized executive of The Aeolian Company.
