CONSOLE Install new electro-pneumatic detached draw knob type console, pedal keyboard and organ bench.

GREAT ORGAN Install complete, new unenclosed and exposed three rank addition to Great Organ, including cabinetwork to enclose chests, etc. as follows:
 4 Principal - 61 pipes and action
 2-2/3 Twelfth - 61 pipes and action
 2 Fifteenth - 61 pipes and action
 Install new 8 Spitz Principal - 61 pipes on present 8 Open Diapason action #1 to #9 and #19 to #61, new action #10 to #18; with #1 to #9 being used for display. Supply 2 new ornamental pipes incorporated in this display.

SWELL ORGAN Install new 1-1/3 Larigot - 61 pipes on present 8 Cornopean action.
 Repack stoppers of present 8 Gedeckt pipes.

PEDAL ORGAN Install new pipes and action for 16 Bourdon #45 to #56 incl.

BLOWER Present motor and blower to be used without change.

GENERATOR Present generator to be used without change.

CABLES Present cables and action current wires to be used.
