Memorandum of Agreement, Made this ... Eight senth

Witnesseth: That the party of the first part hereby agrees to build an organ after and according to the annexed specifications and plans to be hereafter approved by party of second part, and to erect it in .The .First .Preshyterian .Church .Auditorium .at ...

ready for wase on or before the ... First day of October A. D., 192. 6., or as soon thereafter as possible in the event of delays beyond his control.

- 2. The party of the first part agrees that the organ when completed shall be first class, free from defects in material or workmanship, and that the party of the second part may have it examined, immediately on completion, in the presence of representative of first party, by a competent and disinterested expert, and if said examination shows that the organ does not conform with this agreement the party of the first part agrees to remedy defects at his own expense.
- 3. The party of the first part guarantees the action and construction of the organ for a term of one year from date of completion and agrees to correct defects in material or workmanship that may be brought to his attention within that time, without cost to the party of the second part. This does not include tuning or ordinary care of the organ (or electric motors which are guaranteed by the manufacturers for one year).
- 4. In consideration of the above, the party of the second part agrees to pay M. P. Moller, Inc., or order, the sum of Eleven Thousand Eight. Hundred fifty dollars (\$11,850.00).

AS FOLLOWS: \$3954.00 upon the completion and acceptance of the organ; six notes of \$1316.00 each payable in 6,12,18,34,30, and 36 months respectively with interest at 65.

- 5. The party of the second part also agrees that the building will be in proper condition for the installation of the organ. October. Lat. weeks previous to date of completion; that they will allow, free from interruption, suitable convenience and opportunity for the installation in the building, provide such a condition of quiet as is necessary for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the instrument, and necessary light, heat and power.
- 6. The party of the second part also agrees to insure the organ or its parts against loss by fire, water, etc., as soon as the parts are placed in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto, as their interests may appear.

- 7. When electric motor is included in specifications, party of the second part agrees to provide foundation and enclosures when necessary; to furnish and install all wind conductor between blower and organ; to do all wiring connected therewith; to install such lights as may be needed for the erection and future care of the organ, and do any necessary cutting of floors, partitions, or other parts of the building. In the event that automatic remote control motor starter, electrical conduits or other special equipment are required they are to be furnished by party of second part.
- 8. When organ chambers are so located that organ must be hoisted by skids, block and tackle or other mechanical means the necessary apparatus is to be furnished by party of second part.
- 9. It is mutually agreed that the title and ownership of the organ shall remain with party of the first part until the contract price, before mentioned, has been fully paid, after which the instrument shall become the property of the party of the second part; also that all verbal agreements and understandings are merged in this contract, and the specifications and details of construction attached hereto.

Such details and agreements are as follows:

CONSOLE:

To be movable. If length of cable more than 201 be required, purchaser to pay for such excess.

STOT CONTROL:

By Stop keys above the manuals

COUPLERS:

Great to Great 4' to be added.

ADJUSTABLE COMBINATIONS: Six Pistons affecting Swell & Pedal Stops & Coupler " " Great " " " " H H Choir " " Master Pistons acting on all Stops & Couplers

COMBINATION COUTLERS:

Pedal Combination to Great On & Off Piston

DISPLAY PITES & CASING:

Requisite to enclose organ with the understanding that casing is not to be elaborated beyond that of the ordinary organ at same cost, thus eliminating hand carved and figure work.

PEDAL MOVEMENTS:

Sforzando Pedal, Entire Organ. Swell to Pedal Coupler (Reversible). Balanced Crescendo and Sforzando pedals to have visible lights on and off on console.

PIPE SCALE:

First Open Diapason in Great to be Scale #40 Second Open Diapason to be Scale #42

BLOWER:

SPENCER STEEL Orgoblo

Pedal Board both radiating and Concave A.G.O

Mollers agree to build a divided organ without additional cost.
