Gentlemen:

Enclosed find contracts for Portable Organ to be placed in the Chapel of the Nativity, Germantown, Philadelphia, Pa. You will note that the price on this is \$2,725.00, however, I have made them an allowance of \$25.00 for a Two Manual and Pedal Reed Organ with blower. It is my intention to use this organ in Har Zion Temple, should these people put the pressure on us for the use of an organ.

Please make note of the following: they would like to have this organ delivered on Monday, September 15th. This is a definite date and I have told them that every effort will be made to deliver at that time.

In building this organ it will not be necessary to enclose the blower, as it will be placed in the basement under the organ, requiring about 6' of conductor and three elboes.

The current specification is single phase, 60 cycle, 110-220 volts, A.C.
