

## CONCERTS AT DREXEL

Series of Seven to Hear Inauguration  
of \$100,000 Pipe Organ

Set sun early run

With the new \$100,000 pipe organ almost totally installed in the auditorium of Drexel Institute, and the tuning of the huge instrument in progress, it was announced yesterday that a series of seven concerts would be given in the near future.

The first concert will be given in honor of Cyrus H. K. Curtis, donor of the organ. The second will be for the faculty and students, at a regular Wednesday assembly; the third and fourth for the evening school students. The fifth and sixth, one in the afternoon and the other in the evening, will be for the general public, and the seventh and final introductory concert will be for the Alumni Association. William Silvano Thunder, Drexel Institute organist, will play for at least three of the seven concerts, and guest organists will be at the console at the others.
