This agreement made this 12<sup>th</sup> day  
of Dec. 1906 by and between M. P. Moser  
party of the first part and St Paul's  
Epis. Church. Lynchburg, Va party  
of the second part witnesseth -

That the said party of the first  
part does hereby agree to build  
an organ in the above named  
church complete and ready for  
use on or before March 28, 1907  
or as soon thereafter as possible  
in the event of delay by strike  
or other causes beyond the  
control of the party of the first  
part.

Party of the first part further agree  
at his own cost and expense, for  
the term of one year after completion  
to remedy all defects resulting  
from the use of improper material  
or inferior workmanship.

And the party of the second part  
agrees to pay to M. P. Moser or his  
order, the sum of Thirty Three Hundred  
(\$3300) Dollars all the completion  
of the organ.
