Party of the first part further agrees for the term of three years to remedy all defects therein resulting from the use of improper material or inferior workmanship.

Party of the second part agrees to pay to M. O. Moller, or his order, the sum of \$2000.00 at completion as follows: \$1000.00 cash on completion, balance by two notes for equal amounts for six and twelve months, respectively with interest at 6% per annum.
