*The Organ of the St. Paul's Lutheran Church —*

The new church edifice erected at the corner of Brown and St. John street, to replace the building struck by lightning and totally destroyed more than a year since, has been rendered complete by the addition of a powerful organ built by Mr. H. Knauff, of this city. The exterior is peculiarly chaste and appropriate to the building, and the large congregation present on Sunday last, were struck with admiration at the power as well as the delicacy of its tones, which the pieces performed were admirably calculated to bring into play. Among the most admired stops were the mellow tones of the Dulciana, the peculiarity of the Viol di Gamba, the beautiful solo stops, and the trumpet tone which when combined with the deep thunder of the sub-bass, and the choral accompaniment by the whole congregation produced a magnificent effect.
