

Max Reger, one of the greatest of German-composers, wrote a number of monumental fantasies on the great hymn tunes of the Reformation. This one is built on the melody of the "Battle Hymn of the Reformation" which tonight is being sung as the closing hymn, and makes use of all the resources of this great organ.
