It has two manuals and pedal, and includes 17 ranks, or a total of 815 pipes. The front pipes are made of tin, traditionally the finest pipe metal, and were imported from Holland.

The organ is self-contained within a contemporary mahogany case. The pedal and manual towers on the organ are over 13 feet tall. The naturals on the kevboard are covered with ebony wood and the sharps with ivory. This is traditional keyboard design for organs of this time.
