THIS AGREEMENT between ORGAN INDUSTRIES, INC.
20 Washington Road, Princeton Junction, New Jersey, party of
the first part and GRACE EPISCOPAL CHURCH, PEMBERTON, NEW
JERSEY, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual promises herein con-
tained and the acts and conditions herein stipulated to be
performed and fulfilled and the sums of money to be paid by
the party of the second part to the party of the first part
as herein provided, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED:

(a) The party of the first part is hereinafter
referred to as the "Organ Builder".

(b) The party of the second part is hereinafter
referred to as the "Church".

The Organ Builder agrees to complete the following
work in a complete and satisfactory manner.

1. Remove all the manual pipes from the organ, clean
same thoroughly by washing and removing all corrosion.
2. Thoroughly vacuum all organ action and wash down
and dry.
3. Remove all armatures from action magnets and clean.
4. Clean and burnish all relay and switch contacts
and adjust for proper operation.
5. Remove bottom boards manual wind chests and spot
check pipe valve pneumatics to determine exact condition of
leather at this time.
6. Remove pedal key board from console and bring to
Princeton factory for complete rebuilding, to include -
 - (a) New plastic sharps
 - (b) Re-arrange maple naturals
 - (c) Re-felt keys to assure quiet operation

7. Clean and burnish manual key contacts.

8. Re-felt manual key bars to quiet key action.

Also re-felt stop keys.

9. Re-install all pipes, tune and regulate organ in a proper and satisfactory manner.

10. Organ Builder agrees to keep part of the organ playing at all times for Sunday services.

11. All work guaranteed satisfactory. *for 5 years against defects in material & workmanship*

The party of the second part agrees to pay to the party of the first part for materials and services rendered to complete the above specified work the sum of Twenty-nine hundred dollars (\$2,900.00) to be paid as follows: -

~~290.00~~ 10% with the signing of this contract

~~870.00~~ 30% when organ is dismantled and Great and Pedal division cleaned and restored to service.

~~1160.00~~ 40% when Swell Division is finished and restored to service.

~~580.00~~ 20% balance when console is finished and restored to service.
