

Morgan F. Plant Residence Branford Eastern Point, Conn. (Avery Point) 1915, No. 1328

The stoplist is taken from the contract, courtesy the American Organ Archives. There ae two copies, one unmarked, signed by Mr. Plant on June 2nd, 1915, for \$27,500, and a second unsigned copy with various factory annotations in the margins, including the "organ normal" translation out of Aeolian speak, with scale numbers. The stoplist below is taken from the second, annotated version. Both the main organ and Echo were in the basement, with a partition between them, and spoke through grills in the floor. Stop tab console with *Aeolienne* player attachment.

All stops are 8' unless so noted in the stoplist. The reeds were to be mitered to 6' 6" as necessary. The Choir third manual was "compounded" (duplex) from the Great, as the Echo Swell was compounded from the Echo Great. The Celestes are all full compass.
