Agreement to Tune and Maintain in Good Repair the Organ in
Church of the Holy Comforter,

Charlotte,

North Carolina.

We offer to assume the care of the Organ in the Church of the Holy
Comforter

and to send a competent man to visit the same regularly twice annually

for the sum of Thirty

dollars (\$30.00) per annum, payable in quarterly installments of \$ 7.50

upon the first day of December, March, June, and
September.

It is understood that the care of the Organ shall include tuning, and the maintenance of the proper regulation of the action, and the correction of such minor defects as may be due to legitimate wear, but shall not include the repair of damages resulting from carelessness or malice, or heat, dampness, vermin, or other special cause, nor shall it include cleaning or general repairs made necessary by age.

This agreement is to go into effect from and after the first
day of November, 1913, and is unlimited in duration, and shall continue in force until such regular date of payment as shall succeed a written notice from either party announcing his desire to terminate it, notice to be given at least one month prior to such date.
