GENERAL DETAILS OF CONSTRUCTION.

(a) LOCATION.

Main Organ to be located in chamber in basement under Music Room, tone to find egress into Music Room through opening in the floor not less than 3' x 8'. Echo Organ to be located in chamber under Library, tone to find egress into Library through opening in floor not less than 1' x 5'.

(b) CONSOLE

Console, containing two manual and pedal claviers for playing entire Main and Echo Antiphonal Organs, to be located in Music Room, as will be decided later.

(c) AEOLIENNE AND AUTOMATIC

Console to be equipped with The Aeolian Company's special Combination Aeolienne and Automatic Tracker-bar. By means of this and its perforated music rolls, the entire organ, including registration, tempo, expression and tonal pedals, as well as re-roll, may be operated by the performer, or entirely by the roll itself, as desired.

(d) CASE WORK

Case work for Console, Main and Echo Antiphonal Organs, is not included in this proposition.

(e) BLOWING PLANT.

An efficient electric blowing plant to be furnished by organ builder and located in room in basement prepared for that purpose. Also an independent motor generator to be furnished by builder to supply proper low voltage for organ mechanism.

(f) PURCHASER AGREES

To prepare organ chambers in the manner and of the dimensions specified by organ builder; also to install all necessary wind trunking leading from blowing plant to organ and to furnish and install all electric wiring and switches required by blowing plant and to operate it from the Console.

CONTRACT.

We hereby agree to build an Aeolian Pipe Organ in accordance with the foregoing specification and general details of construction, of the highest attainable standard in both workmanship and material throughout, and to install same in the residence of Mr. E. L. Ford, Grosse Pointe Shores, Detroit, Mich., on or before September 1, 1916, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500.00), payable in cash on installation of the organ.

Organ to be at purchaser's risk against damage by fire or water on and after arrival upon his premises.
