THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT this day made and entered into by and between FRED H. MEUNIER, of the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, hereinafter known as the party of the first part, and <sup>B1</sup> ~~THE~~ WELTE-TRIPP ORGAN CORPORATION, of Sound Beach, Connecticut-, a Delaware corporation, hereinafter know as the party of the second part,

9 WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the premises, and of the benefits and burdens accruing to and imposed upon the respective parties hereto, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows, to-wit: \*

Party of the first part agrees to erect, install, complete and ready for use in the Shove Memorial Chapel, at Colorado College, Colorado Springs, Colorado, a pipe organ, which specifications and contract are now of record, said pipe organ is to be manufactured, set up and tested in the factory of and by the party of the second part.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to the party of the first part upon completion of said installation a sum of ten percent of the total purchase price off said organ, and to pay for all material that is used in the completeing of installation ~~and One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per hour for all labor over and above the ten percent installation fee that is required to make such changes that will make the organ acceptable and acceptable to the purchaser~~ and if certain parts or pipes are rejected, that the entire cost of making the change or replacement, will be paid to the party of the first part on the ~~same~~ basis <sup>\$1.50 Per hour and expenses</sup> and if the party of the second part is successful in securing the contract of building the case or parts of the case for this organ this agreement will also apply to the erection and installation of same.

It is further agreed by both parties hereto that the finishing of the organ will be performed by Mr. Whitelegg, whose

salary of \$90.00 (Ninety Dollars) per week is to be deducted from the installation fee and that his time charged to the job will not exceed three weeks also that all his expenses are ~~to be paid by the party of the second part and not charged~~ to the party of the first part, and if for any cause such as, sickness, revoicing, delays, etc., he is required to remain on the job, to make same acceptable, over the three working weeks, his time and expenses will be paid for by the party of the second part.
