DEDICATION OF CHRIST M. E. CHURCH.—
Yesterday, Christ M. E. Church, situated at Thirty-eighth and Bridge streets, West Philadelphia, was dedicated with appropriate exercises, services being held morning, afternoon and evening.

This church has been in course of construction for the past two years, and has cost, including the ground upon which it is built, about \$50,000. It is constructed of Trenton brown stone. On the first floor there are apartments for Sunday School, Bible, Church and infant classes, which, at occasion may require, can all be thrown into one large room. In the rear, and communicating with the Sunday School room, is the pastor's study. The audience room is entered by two large stairways in front. At the pulpit end a recess is formed, the floor being slightly elevated. At the rear end is a large triple window; at the left end of the recess the magnificent organ has been built. The furnishing and furniture of this room are in exact keeping with the fine architecture. A large bell is to be placed in the belfry.
