Pull-down type permanently coupled (but supplied with parts preparatory to make a Manual to Pedal coupler at a future time when a Pedal stop may be added).

 Portions of this rank are placed in the facade.

Pipes 164: 25% tin, 40% tin

Manual Reverse color hardwood: padauk naturals, elm/ebony sharps, 56-note compass C - g'''

Pedal Normal color hardwood, 27-note (C - d'), concave-radiating

Controls Drawknobs, hand-actuated

Casework Stained oak

Voicing Very mild, colorful

Tuning Equal temperament; permanently tuned (Stopped pipes)

Floor area 5'-5 1/2" wide, 5'-4 1/2" depth total

Height 11'

Power Plugs into ordinary 115 volt a.c. wall outlet

Blower Contained in base of casework at rear.
