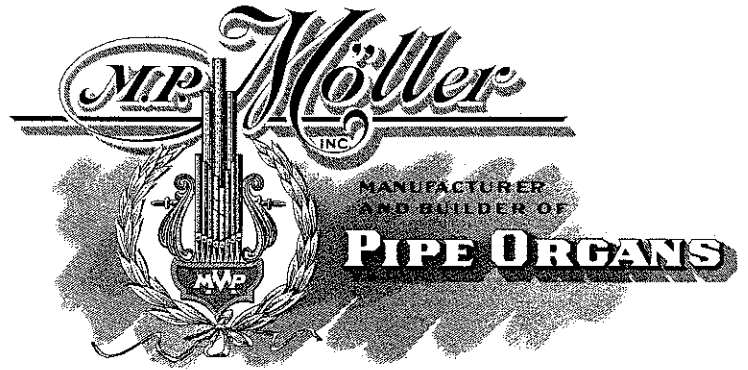

We want to co-operate with you and would like to have your co-operation with us in extending our organs in your community or anywhere else you may know of where organs are needed.

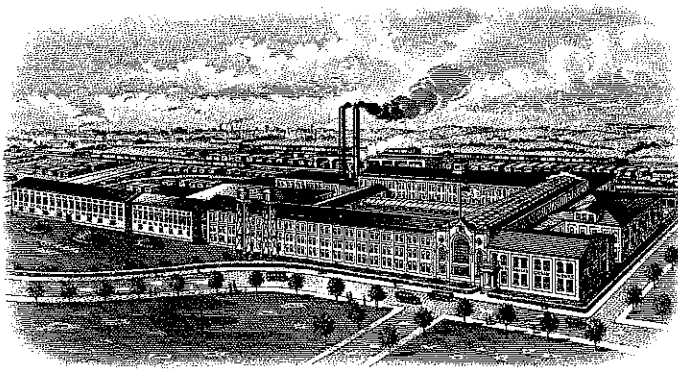
It has been our pleasure in fifty years to build more than five thousand pipe organs, and we want to make it, is possible, ten thousand within the next twenty-five years.

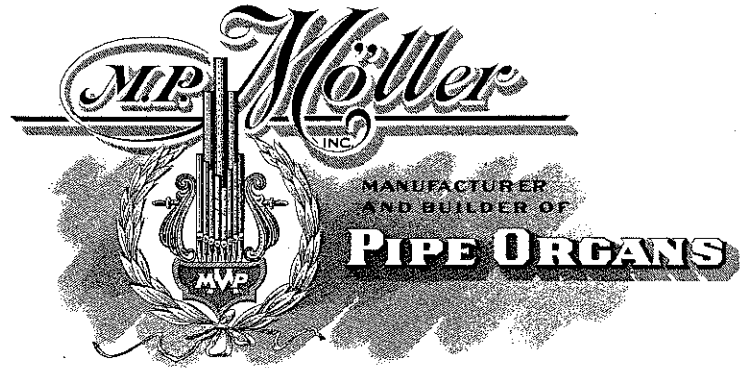

Please send us receipt in full, together with the insurance policy. Will you also kindly send us two keys for the organ console?

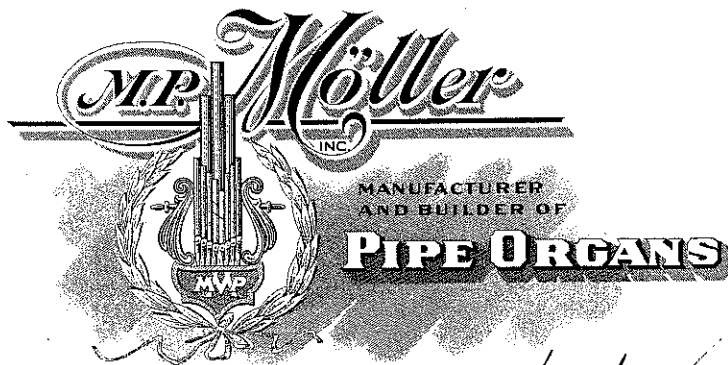
