PISTON COMBINATIONS

Adjustable at the bench. Visibly affecting the registers.

Eight General pistons operating upon the entire organ.
Three Pistons operating upon Great, Pedal, and Couplers.
Three Pistons operating upon Swell, Pedal, and Couplers.

Four General Toe Pistons operating upon the entire organ.
Balanced Swell Pedal

CONSOLE

Console to be new and of the Stop Key type. Case of oak finished to harmonize with the furnishings of the Church. The interior fittings to be of natural varnished walnut. The pedal board will be concave and radiating, and the entire console designed in accordance with the scale adopted by the American Guild of Organists.

GUARANTEE

Every new part of this organ is to be constructed of the very best materials and workmanship throughout. ROSTRON KERSHAW fully warrants and guarantees the new parts for a period of five years from the date of completion in the Church, and will make good without expense to the purchaser, any defective workmanship or materials that may be brought to his attention during that period. This guarantee does not include tuning or adjusting of action, or such care as may be necessary for the proper preservation of the instrument after one year from the date of completion in the Church.

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MEMORANDUM OF AN AGREEMENT

It is this day agreed by and between ROSTRON KERSHAW, ORGAN BUILDER, of READING, MASSACHUSETTS, party of the first part, and EMMANUEL CHURCH, WAKEFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS, party of the second part as follows:

The party of the first part hereby agrees to provide, install, and leave ready for use in the organ of Emmanuel Church, Wakefield, Mass., the following pipe organ materials and services in accordance with the specifications and details hereunto annexed and forming a part of this agreement:

- A new two manual all electric console.
- An electro-pneumatic action throughout.
- Chests and actions for the speaking pipes in the organ case.
- Extend the Pedal Bourdon Compass to include an 8' Stop.
- Releather the bellows; install tuning slides on all present cone tuned pipes; clean the organ and organ chamber; and install an eight station expression motor, rectifier, and tremolo.
- Extend the Manual Bourdon Compass to 97 pipes, and provide unit chest for same; install an 8' Oboe and 8' Dulciana Stop.
- Thoroughly regulate and tune the organ.

The party of the second part hereby agrees to purchase said pipe organ materials and services, and in full consideration therefor, to pay to the party of the first part the sum of Seven Thousand, One Hundred and Seventy-Five Dollars, payments to be made as follows:

- \$2,000.00 on August 1, 1953.
- \$2,000.00 when the console is completed at the factory.
- \$2,000.00 when the parts are delivered to the Church.
- \$1,175.00 when the organ is completed at the Church, and is accepted by the Church.

The party of the second part further agrees, at its own expense, to do all electrical wiring connected with the motor and blower, and to furnish necessary light, power, and heat during the erection, regulation, and tuning of said organ, and to install electric lights as needed. The party of the second part further agrees to allow suitable opportunity and convenience for the proper erection of said organ at the Church, and to examine said organ immediately upon completion thereof, in the presence of the party of the first part, and if found in accordance with the specifications and details, to accept the same in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.

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MEMORANDUM OF AN AGREEMENT (CON'T)

The party of the second part further agrees to make all payments to the order of ROSTRON KERSHAW.

It is mutually acknowledged and agreed that there are no agreements or understandings hereto, except as stated herein.
