

OLD ORGAN REMOVED TO MAKE WAY FOR A NEW

Zion Church to Have Splendid New Instrument By Fall.

The organ in Zion Reformed Church at Church and Hamilton streets has been removed entirely and by September 15 the congregation expects to have the fine new six thousand dollar organ which has been ordered from the C. S. Haskell organ company of Philadelphia, installed. Everything will be new except the case.

The new organ will be a three manual, thirty-four stop organ and will have a set of melody and echo-chimes. The six thousand does not include the phe price of the chimes as they are separate and are a gift from a member of the congregation who wishes to give them in memory of her sister and who does not wish to have her name made public. The Haskell company is known for the high grade organs which they manufacture and the new instrument for Zion will make it one of the finest organs in this section.

In connection with the installing of the organ, the choir will also be moved down from the little gallery on the left and banked in front of the organ. This will also necessitate the moving of the altar rail to a position further front from where it is now situated.

The organ will have all the modern equipment which included an electric blower, which will be installed in the basement.
