

1904 Contract for Pipe Organ, Walnut St M. E. Ch., Chillicothe Ohio

Apr 26 This agreement made this 26th day of April 1904 by and between W. P. Möller of Hagerstown Md., party of the first part, and E. R. McKee, chairman, Building Committee, Walnut Street M. E. Church, Chillicothe Ohio, party of the second part, "witnesseth" That the party of the first part does hereby agree to build an organ according to the specifications and details of construction annexed subject to the approval of W. H. Donley of Indianapolis, Ind. And to deliver the organ set up ready for use in said church on or before Oct 15th A.D. 1904, or as soon thereafter as possible in the event of delay by strikes or other causes beyond the control of the party of the first part.

And the party of the second part hereby agrees to pay W. P. Möller or his order the sum of Two thousand three hundred and Sixty (\$2360.00) dollars, upon presentation of a certificate of acceptance signed by supervising architect, W. H. Donley and approved by the Board of Trustees of said church, of the second part after completion of the organ in the church aforesaid.

Apr 25 Contract for Pipe Organ, First Presbyterian Church, Cadiz Ohio made this 25th day of April 1904 by and between M. P. Möller of Hagerstown Md., party of the first part, and J. F. Kennedy, chairman Board of Trustees, Lillian M. Brown, Alvis Craig of Cadiz Ohio party of the second part. The party of the first does hereby agree to build an organ according to the annexed specification and drawings to be hereafter approved by said second party. And erect the said organ in the First Presbyterian Church of Cadiz, Ohio. Complete and ready for use. And acceptance of said party of the second part, on or before the 15th day of October A.D. 1904, or as soon as possible. In the event of delay by strikes or other causes beyond the control of the party of the first part. And the party of the second part, agrees to pay M. P. Möller, or his order the sum of three thousand five hundred (3500.00) dollars. Less four hundred (\$400.00) dollars allowed by party of the first part for old Pipe organ at the completion and acceptance of the organ in said church. The party of the first agrees to furnish a Ross water motor.
