Dear Rev. Vajda:

The agreement executed in Detroit, Michigan on March 31, 1947 and approved here on April 4, 1947, covering the construction and installation of an organ in The First Hungarian Evangelical and Reformed Church of Detroit, Michigan, includes a clause providing for an increase in the price of the organ, should labor and material costs increase over the levels of that date. We plan to start construction of this organ within the next thirty days, and therefore write to you at this time concerning the price.

Our accountants have just completed a comparison of the cost of labor and material between April 1947 and March 1948, which shows us that our cost of labor has increased more than 11%, while our cost of material has increased more than 16% during this period. A portion of this increased cost has been offset by increased efficiency in the work of construction, but we are compelled to increase the price of the organ by 10%, which will result in the amount increasing from the originally estimated \$11,059.00 to \$12,164.90. There will be a corresponding increase in the Excise Tax, which makes this amount \$1,216.49 instead of \$1,105.90, but there will be no increase on the cost of the cabinet work of \$1,484.00. These increases will show on the invoice which will be submitted to you by our representative in charge of the installation and tone finishing of the organ.

This letter is sent to you in duplicate, and we ask that one copy be acknowledged, signed and returned to us.
