GENERAL DETAILS OF SONSTRUCTION

A-LOCATION:

Organ is to be installed in chamber prepared for it, with location, dimensions, and construction as agreed between purchaser and the Aeolian Company of California.

B-console:

Console sontaining two Manual and Pedal Claviers, to be located at a point to be designated by the purchaser.

C-CASEWORK:

Consobe Case and Organist's Seat, both of Aeolian Standard Design, contructed of native harwood, are included in this contract, but no Organ casework, screen or grilles are so included.

D_BLOWING APPARATUS:

Blowing apparatus including an efficient electric motor wired to suit local electric conditions, and a generator to furnish low voltage for the Organ mechanism, to be furnished by Organ bullders and located in room apart from the organ chamber, to be prepared for this purpose by the purchaser.

E-PURCHASER AGREES:

Purchaser agrees to make necessary preparation for Organ in accordance with information to be furnished by Organ builders; and to install the necessary galvanized iron windtrunking under direction of Organ builders, from bhowing apparatus to Organ and Console, and to bear all expense of wiwiring, conduiting and switches for current, also to provide wirinig and lights for the Organ chamber and motor room and console.
