THIS AGREEMENT

Made this 24 day of September A. D., 1914 between
HILLGREEN, LANE & COMPANY, OF ALLIANCE, OHIO, of the first part, and
The Casino Theatre Co. of Detroit, Mich
..... of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the party of the first part HEREBY AGREES to build an
Organ according to the specifications annexed, and to erect the same in the.....
Washington Theatre, Clifford Washington Streets
having it completed and ready for use on or about the 24 day of Oct 1914.

Should said Organ, upon examination by a competent and disinterested expert se-
lected by second party, be found not to accord with the specifications and terms of this
agreement, said first party agrees, at its own cost and expense, to at once make good any
defect, or failing in this, to remove said Organ from the building, and the party of the
second part shall no longer be held by the terms of this agreement.

And said first party further agrees, at its own cost and expense, for the term of
three years next after the completion of said Organ, to remedy any and all defects therein,
resulting from the use of improper materials or from inferior workmanship.

And the second party hereby agrees to pay to HILLGREEN, LANE & CO., or to
their order, the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars

payable upon acceptance of Organ as follows:

Eight Hundred Dollars Cash
Subject to change
One note on 6 months for Seven Hundred Dollars
One note on 12 months for Seven Hundred Dollars
One note on 18 months for Seven Hundred Dollars
Notes to bear 6 per cent interest.

And the party of the second part further agrees, that said building and Organ
Chamber shall be in readiness for the erection, tuning and regulating of said Organ, includ-
ing the conveniences of light, heat and power, and subject to the possession of representa-
tives of the party of the first part for a period 14 days next previous to specified time
for completion of Organ.

And the party of the second part further agrees to have Organ examined immedi-
ately on completion, so that the party of the first part, or its representatives, shall not
suffer delay.

And the party of the second part further agrees to assume all risk of damage to
said Organ, or parts thereof, when placed inside the building it is to occupy; and to receive
the Organ upon its arrival, cart it to the building and pay the freight thereon, said freight
and cartage to be deducted from the price of the Organ, and such reception and care not
to be construed as an acceptance of said Organ.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, made this 11th day
of September, 1915, between Hillgreen, Lane and Company,
Alliance, Ohio, as first party and John H. Kunsky, Inc.,
Detroit, Michigan, second party, WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the payment by second
party to first party of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00)
Dollars, first party hereby sells to second party the
organ now installed at the Washington Theatre, Detroit,
Michigan. First party further agreeing at its own cost
and expense for a term of two years from date, to remedy
any and all defects therein resulting from the use of
improper materials or from inferior workmanship.

It is further agreed that this agreement shall
cancel all rentals to be paid from September 1st, 1915,
and shall cancel the certain agreement made September 24th,
1914 for the rental of said organ.
