Gentlemen:

Enclosed find signed contracts for the four Stop Unit organ now in the E. U. B. Church, New Kingstown, Pa. which we are to install in the above church. Check in the amount of \$450.00, covering down payment of 10% is also enclosed. The price (\$4,500.00) for this particular organ was one given me by the Hagerstown office.

As previously stated it will not be necessary to rebuild this organ at the factory, providing it has been or will be dismantled and stored with a reasonable amount of care. It can be readily be adapted to the new organ chamber on the job as the only new material needed will be a few pieces of various size conductor pipe and elbows. I will order the necessary new parts when advising you the church is ready for the new organ. This should be sometime during February or March 1952.
