Compasses: 58/27

Pitch and pressure: repitched to A436?, w.p. 67mm (2 5/8")
Mechanical drawknob stop action.

[8] Dulciana	C-B Quintadena, then t.c. Dulciana
[4] Octave	C-E zinc, remainder common metal

[8] Viola	II. Man. common metal, t.c; box beards 13-17; softened to become
[8] St'd. Diap'n.	II. Man. wood, t.c.; c#³-a³ open flues, common metal; partially ca. 1890 Aeoline
[8] Unison Bass	II. Man. 1-12 wood
[4] Flute	II. Man. 1-5 zinc, then common metal, open cylindrical
