Monday noon at 12 o'clock, Arthur Poister, faculty member and organist of the University of Redlands, Calif., will give an organ recital in Kilbourn Hall, primarily for the students and teachers of the Eastman School of Music and of the University of Rochester. The public is invited to hear Professor Poister. He is a former student of Edwin Arthur Craft and of Marcel Dupre, in Paris. His recitals in California won him a reputation which has reached eastward to New York, whither he was summoned to play a recital in the Wanamaker auditorium.
