After completing studies at a school for teachers in 1962, he entered the Conservatory of "Musiclyceum-Society" in Amsterdam, where he earned his certificates in 1968, studying with Herman Glekkenhorst and Piet Kee, the famed organist of Alkmaar and Haarlem. As a composer, he has written music for piano, organ, violin with continuo, and radio plays. He has played many recitals in the Netherlands and is completing a short recital tour of the United States. At present, Mr. Von Veelen holds the position of organist at the Old Church in Zandvoort and is teaching piano and organ at a music school in Haarlem.
