

ARTICLES OF AN AGREEMENT made this 18th day of March 1920, by and between Skinner Organ Company, Organ Builders, of Boston, Massachusetts, party of the first part, and Plymouth church of Shaker Heights, Cleveland, Ohio, party of the second part

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of twenty thousand three hundred (20,300) dollars, to be paid by the party of the second part to the party of the first part, the said party of the first part agrees to build an organ according to the annexed specifications, in a most thorough and artistic manner and install it in Plymouth Church, Shaker Heights, Cleveland, Ohio, complete in every detail and fully warranted on or before February 15th, 1921.

The party of the second part agrees that during the installation of the said organ, they will keep said church at such reasonable temperature as may be required by the party of the first part; that they will provide and allow the use of the electric current for tuning and lighting; that they will afford such a condition of quiet within the building as may be needful for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the instrument, and that they will allow suitable convenience and opportunity for the installation and completion of the organ in the said church, free from unreasonable interruption.

The party of the second part agrees to insure the organ as soon as it or it's parts shall have been deposited in the church, for the benefit of the parties hereunto, as their interests may appear.

The party of the second part may have the option of omitting such itens from the annexed specifications as will reduce the contract price to fifteen thousand (15,000) dollars. Such option must be exercised before July 1, 1920.

The party of the second part further agrees to pay the party of the first part the sum of twenty thousand three hundred (20,300) dollars as follows:

Two-thirds upon the delivery of the organ at the church exclusive of the smaller pipes; balance upon the completion and acceptance of said organ.

The organ to be erected in the church, tuned and left ready for use.

The action to be electro-pneumatic.

Suitable electric blowing machinery to be provided, exclusive of wiring.

No masons' or builders' work included in this contract (any possible structural alterations in the building.)

Exclusive of case or display pipes.
