## DETERILS

When Mr. Stouder and his organist looked over the various specifications they found that all of them specified atwelfth or Nazard and most of them had a Tierce 1-3/5. They insisted that they should have some of these (small) stops as they are very usefull in combination with others. I do not know the composition of the great Mixture but presume it is the 12th, 15th and 17th, if you could give them a separate stop key for each rank it would give them the effect desired, or you could take the 12th from the Quintadena or Doppel Floete.

The organ is to be set in two chambers one on each side of stage above boxes these chambers are large but the openings are small. It will require a large scale and high pressure to get the tone through the building. This Theatre seats over 2000 and has two large balconies. I asked for 8" wind pressure not only to get power but for promptness in speech. The organist here is a young man, a brilliant player and wants (pep) he was almost sold on the Wurlitzer on account of the rapid action. I promised him a fast action.

The console is to be of cherry or birch finished dark red (will send sample). Exakks the keyboard and trimmings to be mahogany piano finish, swell keyboard declined or slanting towards great, choir keyboard inclined towards great. Color system of stop keys to be used and set in a circular form in the order of most unit organs. Couplers with their stops or in other words all couplers to great to be placed with great group etc. Manual keys to have 5 ounce resistance.
