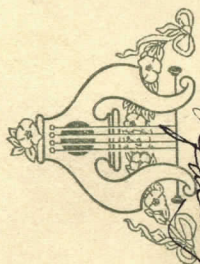

64. By means of the Duo-Art Player, in conjunction with Aeolian Pipe-Organ Duo-Art Records, the stops, expression, tempo, etc., are automatically controlled.

Items from #38 to end of this specification are subject to revision to conform to Aeolian Pipe-Organ Standard Console Equipment, if improvements are adopted between the signing of this contract and construction of the organ.

NOTE: (See also paragraph on preparations and omissions on page 4d)

Items nos. 2, 6, 8, 11, 13, 17, 21, 23, 26, 28, 33, 34, are to be prepared for only, that is space for their later addition is to be provided in the organ-chamber, and the necessary controls are to be placed in the console, so that no great changes will have to be made in either organ chamber or in console to later accommodate these items thus now prepared for.

Likewise, the organ is now to be built as a single expression organ, this to be made double expression at some future time. At first installation the console is to be equipped with swell pedal for this second expression, and with stop-tablet for second Tremolo, so that change from single expression to double expression will not cause any work of importance to be done on the console aside from necessary wiring.

GENERAL DETAILS OF CONSTRUCTION

(a) LOCATION

Organ to be located in room in basement and in space above first floor of residence as provided on house plans according to data worked out by architect and THE AEOLIAN COMPANY. Tone to find egress into Great Hall, Living Room and Hallway, thru tone openings of adequate size provided for this purpose.

(b) KEY CONSOLE

Key console, containing two manual and one pedal claviers for manual playing including case-work of THE AEOLIAN COMPANY's standard design in and equipped as per the foregoing specification, to be located in recess into organ space as shown on house plans.

(c) DUO-ART CONSOLE

Duo-Art console, containing necessary duo-art mechanism and controls, including case-work of THE AEOLIAN COMPANY's standard Duo-Art Console design in, to be located in Music Room.

(d) GRILLES

Grilles for tone-openings are not included in this proposition.

(e) PIANO CONNECTION

A grand piano (furnished by the purchaser) is to be connected with the organ. It is to be playable from the organ key-boards, and also by means of Aeolian Pipe-Organ Duo-Art Records, (as a part of the organ,) from the Duo-Art console. Piano is to be delivered to THE AEOLIAN COMPANY, Pipe-Organ Department, Garwood, New Jersey, not later than April 15, 1927.

(f) PREPARATIONS AND OMISSIONS

Certain stops and accessories, as indicated in specification by "(see note)", and itemized in details in the NOTE on page 3, are to be omitted for the present, but space is to be left for them in the organ-chamber, and necessary controls to be inserted in the console, so that no structural changes will be necessary in the console, when items thus prepared for are added. It is understood that these items are to be added by THE AEOLIAN COMPANY at prices current when these additions are purchased, said time of purchase to be at the option of the purchaser.

(g) PURCHASER AGREES:

To provide organ chamber and blower room in accord with dimensions and specifications of THE AEOLIAN COMPANY; to install necessary wind-trunks and conduits from the blower to organ, keyboard console and duo-art console; to connect blower and remote control starter to the power current. to receive said organ in accordance with the terms of this contract. (Should there be delay in the completion of the residence, or of the organ chamber or blower room, etc., purchaser agrees to assume all charges for storage and other incidentals thereto, unless notice of said delay is given to organ-builder at least three months before shipment date from the factory.

C O N T R A C T

We, THE AEOLIAN COMPANY, hereby agree to build and deliver F. O. B. cars at Garwood, New Jersey, and Aeolian Pipe-Organ, according to the foregoing Specifications and General Details of Construction, which are hereby made part of this contract, of the highest attainable standard in both workmanship and material, and to erect same in the residence of the purchaser, MR. WAITE PHILLIPS, at Tulsa, Oklahoma, on or before July 1st. 1927 unless delayed by fire, water, strikes, or other causes beyond our control, for and in consideration

of, the sum of

Sixteen thousand eight hundred and fifty Dollars, (\$ 16850.00)

payable in New York Exchange as follows:-

Sixteen hundred eighty-five Dollars, (\$ 1685.00)

on signing of this contract:

Seven thousand five hundred eighty-two and 50/100 Dollars, (\$ 7582.50)

when organ is ready for shipment from Garwood, New Jersey:

Seven thousand five hundred eighty-two and 50/100 Dollars, (\$ 7582.50)

when organ is installed.

It is understood and agreed that said organ is at the risk of said purchaser against damage by fire, water, or other natural cause, on and after a rival upon his premises, and further, that the title ownership of said organ shall remain vested in THE AEOLIAN COMPANY until said organ is fully paid for as hereinbefore provided.
