Al Milz and Jerry Heino reported on financial status of the church. It was reported that there was a shortage of \$47,000 for the envelopes turned in so far for 1969. Walcker came in with a price of \$44,200. Building Committee portable organ till at a time where there is more money. 1973 was felt to be perhaps the right time. Mr. Beckendorf reported that it was not advised to move the old organ unless it were to be used for 10 years- no cost was given. He estimated that the cost might be around \$15,000 to make the old organ useable. By 1973 the same organ from Walcker Co. would be \$20,000 higher

Motion made and supported to cancel the letter with Cavant Co, to look into a pipe organ or a portable organ. Motion carried
