

This organ has ten basic registers, plus the additional ranks of the independent mixture. These registers, when taken together, form a moderate sized straight organ chorus. The unification into the above specification adds much to the instrument's flexibility.

In designing the organ, with its mahogany panelling, care was taken to assure that the appearance of the instrument would be in keeping with the contemporary style of architecture in the residence.
