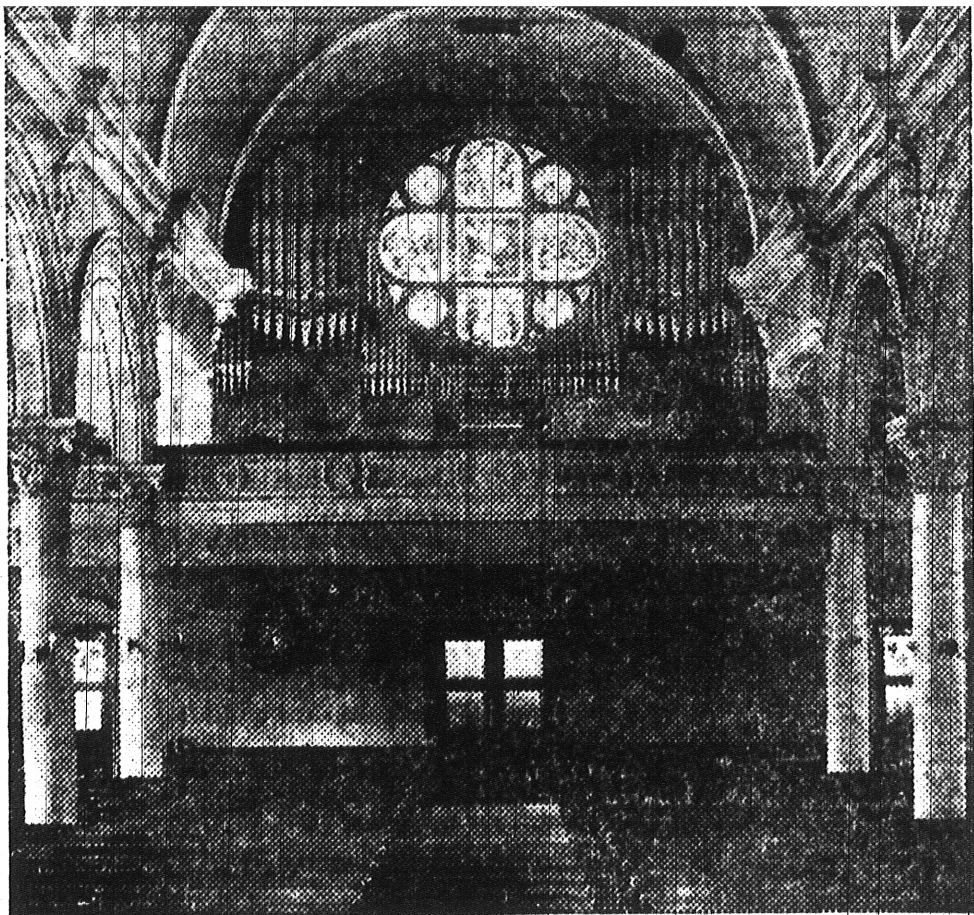


Recital Tonight Celebrates New \$10,000 Pipe Organ at St. Philip's.



The opening organ recital in St. Philip's church, celebrating installation of one of the finest pipe organs in Battle Creek, is to be held this evening. It supplants one which has been used for years and which originally was installed in a private home.

With the building of the handsome addition to St. Philip's church two years ago, the organ that has been in use was deemed insufficient and plans were made about six months ago to purchase a larger one, to cost \$10,000. Experts from the factory have been installing it the last three days.
