This agreement made this 28th day of May 1908 M. P. Moller, party of the first part and First Presbyterian Church, San Angelo, Texas, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

The party of the second part does hereby agree to build an organ complete and ready for use on or before October 1st 1908.

The party of the first part further agrees for the term of three years, to remedy all defects therein resulting from the use of improper materials or inferior workmanship.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to M. P. Moller or his order the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred (\$3500⁰⁰) Dollars as follows: \$1500⁰⁰ cash and balance in three equal notes due on or before, one, two and three years from their dates, at 6% interest.
