Know all men by these presents That We Frederick

Township in the County of Berks and State of Pennsylvania
are held and firmly bound unto Jacob Saffaman and
Peter Lichtywalter, members of the Lutheran and Reformed
Congregations of "Liegele" Church situate in Weisenberg
Township Northampton County in the sum of eight hundred
and fifty dollars in Gold and Silver Money to be paid
to the said Jacob Saffaman & Peter Lichtywalter or
to their certain Attorney Executors Administrators or
assigns, In Trust to and for the use and benefit of the Luthe-
ran and Reformed Congregation aforesaid to which
payment well and truly to be made We do bind ourselves
and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors
and Administrators jointly Severally for and in the whole
firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals Dated
the Twenty four day of November — in the year of Our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and Ten.

Whereas the aforesaid Frederick Obenhousen
Jr. did for the Consideration of the sum of Four hundred
and twenty five dollars in specie to him in hand ^{paid} or secured
to be paid, make finish and sell unto the Congregation
aforesaid an Organ which he has delivered and placed
in the said Church. Now the said Frederick Obenhousen
Jr. doth hereby for himself his heirs Executors and Ad-
ministrators warrant the said Organ to be good in
all and every respect and to remain good & sufficient
for the Space of four years.

And the Condition of this Obligation is such
that if the said Organ shall within the time aforesaid
prove defective or insufficient in the Opinion
of any three Artists who shall have no Interest
therein. And if the said Frederick Obenhousen

his heirs Executors and Administrators shall Repair
amend and render the same good & sufficient or
if he shall pay unto the said Congregation the
consideration money of four hundred & twenty five
dollars aforesaid and save the said Congregation
harmless & indemnified on account of the said
Organ. without any fraud or further delay. Then
this obligation to be void, or else to be and remain
in full force and virtue.
