

## TEMPLE BAPTISTS HEAR NEW ORGAN

Appreciative Audience Fills  
Church Auditorium.

Members and friends of Temple Baptist Church, Felix Avenue and Cooper Street, had the pleasure yesterday afternoon of hearing for the first time the new pipe organ recently installed. A programme of sacred music was rendered by Laurent Chaveaux, organist and choir master, and assisted by the church choir of 40 voices.

It was estimated that over 1,000 were included in the appreciative audience and praise of both the organ and the choir were heard on all sides at the close of the programme.

To Dr. Robert A. Fagin, chairman of the music committee of the church, and his associates on the committee, is due much of the credit for securing the beautiful instrument which was opened yesterday. It is not uncommon when a new church has been built for the congregation to wait for some time for an organ in keeping with the building. But Dr. Fagin was unwilling for this to be the case at Temple Church, and his enthusiasm and energy insured those interested in the church music to put forth extraordinary efforts to secure an organ as soon as possible after the building of the new church.

It is not known just how much was contributed yesterday to the organ fund, but Rev. J. Carl McCoy, pastor of the church, estimates the amount at something in excess of \$1,000.
