This agreement made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1909-M. P. Moller Party of the first part and The North Baptist Church, Detroit, Mich. Party of the second part, Witnesseth.

The party of the first part does hereby agree to build an organ complete and ready for use on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1910 or as soon thereafter as possible.

The party of the first part further agrees for the term of five years, to remedy all defects therein resulting from the use of improper material or inferior workmanship.

The party of the second part agrees to pay to M. P. Moller, or his order, the sum of \$7460<sup>00</sup> at completion and acceptance, as follows: Four lots for a consideration of \$1400<sup>00</sup> to be deeded M. P. Moller upon completion of the organ, \$2000<sup>00</sup> in cash at the same time, \$2000<sup>00</sup> in one year, \$2000<sup>00</sup> in two years from date of completion with interest from date.

It is hereby agreed that the erection of the organ in the church to be in charge of Mr. Marshall Rinker and that the action and tone regulating shall be done by him, personally, and all the erection and regulating work shall be under the supervision of the organ architect Mr. W. H. Donley.
