

Memorandum of Agreement, Made this 39th
day of April A. D., 1929 by and between M. P. MOLLER, Inc., of Hagerstown,
Maryland party of the first part, and

Witnesseth: That the party of the first part hereby agrees to build an organ after and
according to the annexed specifications and plans to be hereafter approved by party of second
part, and to erect it in Holy Family R. C. Church, 1515 S. Washington,
Sagiraw, Mich
ready for use on or before the
or as soon thereafter as possible in the event of delays beyond his control.
2. The party of the first part agrees that the organ when completed shall be first class, free from
defects in material or workmanship, and that the party of the second part may have it examined
immediately on completion, in the presence of representative of first party, by a competent and
disinterested expert, and if said examination shows that the organ does not conform with this
agreement the party of the first part agrees to remedy defects at his own expense.
The party of the first part guarantees the action and construction of the organ for a term of
ene year from date of completion and agrees to correct defects in material or workmanship that
may be brought to his attention within that time, without cost to the party of the second part.
This does not include tuning or ordinary care of the organ (or electric motors which are guaran-
teed by the manufacturers for one year).
4. In consideration of the above, the party of the second part agrees to pay M. P. Moller, Inc.,

5. The party of the second part also agrees that the building will be in proper condition for the
installation of the organfourweeks previous to date of completion; that they
will allow, free from interruption, suitable convenience and opportunity for the installation in the building, provide such a condition of quiet as is necessary for the proper tone regulation and tuning
of the instrument, and necessary light, heat and power.
6. The party of the second part also agrees to insure the organ or its parts against loss by fire,
6. The party of the second part also agrees to make the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto, water, etc., as soon as the parts are placed in the building, for the benefit of the parties hereto,
as their interests may appear.  This is to be a complete installation except the city power.  This is to be a complete installation except the city power.

This contract is not in force until a personal bond for \$10,00 has been received by purchaser.



- 7.—When electric motor is included in specifications, party of the second part agrees to provide foundation and enclosures when necessary; to furnish and install all wind conductor between blower and organ; to do all wiring connected therewith; to install such lights as may be needed for the erection and future care of the organ, and do any necessary cutting of floors, partitions, or other parts of the building. In the event that automatic remote control motor starter, electrical conduits or other special equipment are required they are to be furnished by party of second part.
- 8. When organ chambers are so located that organ must be hoisted by skids, block and tackle or other mechanical means the necessary apparatus is to be furnished by party of second parts.
- 9. It is mutually agreed that the title and ownership of the organ shall remain with party of the first part until the contract price, before mentioned, has been fully paid, after which the instrument shall become the property of the party of the second part; also that all verbal agreements and understandings are merged in this contract, and the specifications and details of construction attached hereto.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, M. P. Moller, Inc., of Hagerstown, Maryland, is held and firmly bound into the Holy Family R. C. Church, of Saginaw, Michigan, in the full and just sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us and of our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns jointly and severally, by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this sixth day of July, 1929. WHEREAS, said M. P. Moller, Inc., has entered into written contract providing for the installation of an organ in the Holy Family R. C. Church, Saginaw, Michigan, bearing date June 11, 1929 and agrees to furnish all material and to perform all labor required in connection with installing said organ in the building of Holy Family R. R. Church, at Saginaw, Michigan, and complete said work in a coordance with contract above referred to. The completion date is subject to delays and not guaranteed by this bond. NOW THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that if said M. P. Moller, Inc. shall well and truly perform said contract and all of its stipulations, provisions and agreements as contained therein, then this obligation is to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect. It is understood and agreed that no extension of time given the said M. P. Moller, Inc., for the performance of said contract or any portion thereof and no changes or alterations of said contract shall release the suret --- herein. This bond shall also be held for the protection of persons furnishing labor and material for the said M. P. Moller, Inc. to be used upon said work, and suit may be brought on this bond by such persons whose bills are unpaid, providing, however, that before beginning such suit ten (10) days notice in writing shall be given.
