Notes on Reuter Organ Opus 1632 St. James Episcopal Church • Wheat Ridge, Colorado

Father Minnis and several members visited our shop in December 1966 to discuss the organ project.

In a letter dated 12.31.66, from Ivan P. Morel to Rev. William Minnis;

"In the event that say in a few years you decided to enlarge this proposed organ, we could one of two things. Either expand the existing organ, or if the church decided to go all new on a different tonal design, we then would buy back the organ from the church, deducting \$100.00 per year of use from the original price paid by the church. For example, say in five years time, we would give you \$6,036.00 for the existing instrument towards the purchase of a larger pipe organ, Reuter of course! Actually you would have had the services of the instrument for less than \$2.00 per Sunday."
