

AN ORGAN PRESENTATION

Uptown Methodist Episcopal Church the Recipient of a Fine Instrument.

The presentation services of a four thousand dollar pipe organ were held yesterday morning and evening in the East Allegheny Avenue Methodist Episcopal Church. The morning services were conducted by the Rev. J. S. Hughes, D. D., who preached from Revelations 1, 12. The evening sermon was preached by the Rev. J. R. T. Gray, D. D., who based his theme on "Divine Worship."

Both services were interspersed with vocal selections and voluntaries by Dr. Minor C. Baldwin, of New York, who was concert organist at the World's Fair and the Omaha Exposition. Among the features of the evening service was a soprano solo rendered by Miss Evelyn M. Webster, of Louisville, who has become famous for her church singing as well as that upon the operatic stage.

This pipe organ, manufactured by the John Brown Company, of Wilmington, Del., is one of the finest in the city, and was presented to the church by Mrs. Porter, wife of the late Isaac Porter, who not only paid for the organ, but bore all expenses due to the altering of the church pulpit and of placing the instrument in position in the church.
