

ARTICLES OF AN AGREEMENT made this.....*second*.....
day of.....*December*.....1916, by and between THE ERNEST M. SKINNER
COMPANY, Organ Builders, of Boston, Massachusetts, party of
the first part, and.....*First Church of Christ, Scientist, Quincy, Mass.*.....
party of the second part.

For and in consideration of the sum of Three
Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$3,230.00) to be paid
by the party of the second part to the party of the first part,
the said party of the first part agrees to build an organ,
according to the annexed specifications, in a most thorough
and artistic manner, and install it in the FIRST CHURCH OF
CHRIST SCIENTIST, Quincy, Massachusetts, complete in every
detail and fully warranted on or before March 1, 1917.

The party of the second part agrees that during
the installation of the said organ, they will keep said church
at such reasonable temperature as may be required by the party
of the first part; that they will provide and allow the use
of the electric current for tuning and lighting; that they will
afford such a condition of quiet within the building as may be
needful for the proper tone regulation and tuning of the in-
strument, and that they will allow suitable convenience and
opportunity for the installation and completion of the organ
in the said building, free from unreasonable interruption.

The party of the second part agrees to insure the
organ as soon as it or its parts shall have been deposited in
the building, for the benefit of the parties hereunto, as their
interests may appear.

The party of the second part further agrees to
pay the party of the first part the sum of Three Thousand Two
Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$3,230.00) as follows:-

Two-thirds upon the delivery of the organ at the church exclusive of the smaller pipes; balance upon the completion and acceptance of said organ.
