Description of Organ

Tonal scheme of our three-manual Austin organ is the work of Clarence Mader, who acted as consultant for the church. The entire organ is on three and one-half inch pressure with the Great unenclosed — all divisions being in a chamber above the rostrum and speaking directly into the church through an open grille.
