NOTES

A few tonal changes were made to the original specification as evidenced by tapedon new labels in the OHS Database posted photos of the divisional stops.

St. Ignatius closed in July, 2022 after the Archdiocese of Chicago decided to merge its services and congregation with two other nearby parishes: St. Gertrude at 1420 W. Granville Ave., and St. Jerome at 1709 W. Lunt Ave. Fate of the organ is presently unknown.
