My dear Sir: In response to your request I have examined the organ in the Universalist Church of the Redeemer. As you know, the organ came from our factory in 1871 and to my knowledge, nothing in the way of repairs has been done to it since. I find that the action has become very badly worn and a few sets of pipes are now practically useless and others should be replaced with sets that are more modern and useful. The total cost of the work complete would be \$490.00 and with these improvements I can assure you that the organ will be in first class order and last for many years. The organ in its present condition is very unsatisfactory and it will be absolutely necessary to overhaul it in a very short time. If I can be of further service to you I shall be glad to do so.
