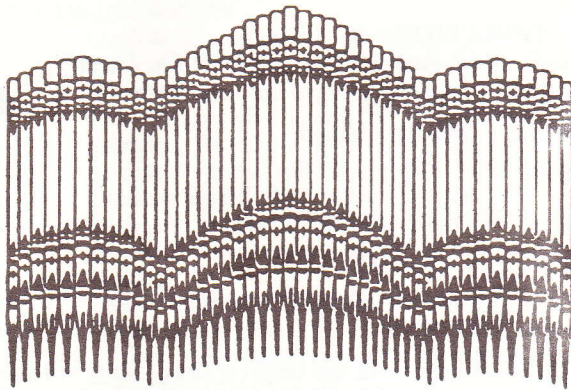

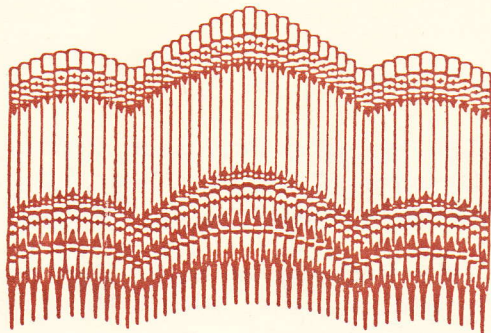

Dan Garland, founder of Garland Pipe Organs, Inc., became interested in pipe organs as a child having grown up as an active member of First Presbyterian Church in Fort Worth, Texas. In 1966 he started assisting the Minister of Music at First Presbyterian, William Barclay. Barclay allowed him to have access to the organ chambers as well as allowing him to complete minor tunings. During high school (1968-70) he built a small pipe organ for his home. In 1970 Garland enrolled at Texas Wesleyan College as a Music Education major with a concentration in Organ Performance. While a student at TWC he was given a workshop to rebuild the instrument in the Fine Arts Auditorium. Upon graduation in 1975 he began working as an apprentice for a local organ builder, as well as spending 9 months working for a firm in Austin, Texas. In 1982 he started his own company, based in Fort Worth. When the company first started primary income was from organ service work through out Texas and Louisiana. As the firm grew more and more time was spent completing major renovations and building new instruments. Today, approximately 80% of the firms time is spent completing such projects, with 20% time spent doing service work. The San Angelo instrument is the 20th major project completed by the firm since 1982. At present the firm is building a instrument of 60 ranks for the First Presbyterian Church in Monroe, Louisiana, and a smaller instrument for St. John's Episcopal Church in Minden, Louisiana. Next years projects include a major renovation for St. Stephen Presbyterian in Fort Worth as well as a new instrument for University United Methodist also in Fort Worth.

Garland is active at First Presbyterian in Fort Worth where he serves as an assistant in the music department as well as curator of the pipe organs. He is also involved in Scouting in Fort Worth; he served for many years as a staff member at Worth Ranch in Palo Pinto County. In 1992 he was listed in Who's Who Among Rising Young Americans.
